Good job on the fake news NYU, but we call BS!

Actions speak louder than words. If you really want to “put employees first” and “bargain in good faith,” then why are you refusing to release a sufficient number of employees to represent us in negotiations? We can't bargain fairly with only

25 members representing all 7,500 of us. This looks more like slashing our union strength than bargaining in good faith, just like leaving the League without consulting us looked more like opaque business dealings than transparency.

Enough with the rhetoric. We need broad representation now! Let's get on the phone and demand that Nancy Sanchez release a minimum of 45 bargaining committee members.
