The review course contents are based on the TCRN exam with topics on the assessment and management of Traumatic injuries of the chest, Abdomen, Spinal cord/ head, Genito-Urinary, and special populations such as pediatric, obstetric, and geriatric patients. The course will feature lectures, interactive discussion, and practice test sessions.

TARGET AUDIENCE: Professional Registered Nurses in Emergency Department, Surgical Intensive Care Units, and Post-anesthesia Recovery Care Units.

Program Objectives

This program prepares the learner to:

- Describe the aspects of the continuum of care from the prehospital setting, acute care, rehabilitation, and end-of-life management.
- State the assessment, mechanism of injury, and potential complications of traumatic injuries
- Discuss the different types of shock and current treatment modalities, including the management of permissive hypotension with damage control resuscitation and massive transfusion
- Describe appropriate nursing interventions and medical and surgical treatment modalities for traumatic injuries
- Identify the issues in disaster management, and emerging trends for trauma management
- Describe the professional issues of trauma regulations and accreditation, quality management, ethics, and safety issues.

Participant Requirements

- Knowledge of basic anatomy and physiology of the human body
- Knowledge of basic resuscitation skills
- For the TCRN exam, the Board Certification for Emergency Nurses (BCEN®) recommends two years of trauma nursing experience at an average of 1,000 practice hours per year across the trauma care continuum

REGISTRATIONS FOR ELIGIBLE MEMBERS: *This is a 2-day educational benefit at no cost for all 1199 nurses whose employers contribute to the 1199 RN Training, Upgrading and Job Security Fund. However, you are required to submit a check in the amount of \$60.00 as a security deposit for your attendance. If you attend both days of the seminar your check will be returned to you on the last day of class. If you miss any part of the 2 days or do not cancel your registration within 14 days prior to the beginning of class you will forfeit your security deposit. Should your check bounce or be returned for insufficient funds, you will be required to reimburse the full amount plus any bank fees incurred.*

REGISTRATION FOR NON-ELIGIBLE REGISTRANTS: Based on space availability, this course is open to **1199 members from non-participating institutions at a cost of \$220 in advance and \$240 at the door.** Non-1199 registrants may take this class at \$260 in advance and \$280 at the door. Checks should be made payable to the 1199 LEAGUE OF REGISTERED NURSES.

REFUND POLICY: **NO REFUNDS will be given after the 14-DAY CANCELLATION PERIOD PRIOR TO THE START OF CLASS OR FOR A NO-SHOW ON THE DAY OF THE SEMINAR.** Two to four weeks are required to process a refund. Requests for cancellations or a refund is required 14 days in advance of the scheduled seminar date.
